REPRESENTATIVE PERONE APPOINTED TO 'COURAGE TO SPEAK FOUNDATION' ADVISORY BOARD

The non-profit organization, "Courage to Speak Foundation," recently named **State Rep. Chris Perone** (**D-Norwalk**) as a member of its advisory board.

"Attending Courage to Speak meetings has been a great way to ensure that I am working in Hartford with the best interests of Norwalk in mind," said Rep. Perone. "I look forward to being able to take a more active and leadership role now that I have been placed on the group's advisory board."
