


Sunny's Story: How to Save a Young Life from Drugs

NORWALK-- She usually tells the story to children: That of the well-like boy who earned his black belt in grade school, played sports in high school and took honors courses at the University of Hartford before overdosing heroin at the age of 20.

This month, however, Ginger Katz will bring the story of her son, Ian, to adults throughout Fairfield County with a drug prevention seminar called Courageous Parenting 101.

"Even if you think your children will never do drugs, you have to learn about everything they're going to be exposed to," said Katz, founder of the Courage to Speak Foundation.

Holiday Celebration Tips



Let your child know what you expect. Tell your child that adults may be drinking during the holidays but under no circumstances are they allowed to consume alcohol.

Plan a nonalcoholic holiday party with your child so children learn that they can have fun without alcohol.

For your holiday meal, let your child help you prepare and serve traditional drinks without alcohol. Examples: cider, eggnog, or punch.

Make sure your holiday festivities involve lots of delicious-and nonalcoholic-food, which your child can help you make.

If your older child is going to a holiday event, call ahead to make sure that the event will be alcohol and drug free.
