Courage to Speak - Courageous Parenting 101TM is a free five-session drug course designed specifically for the parents of upper elementary, middle and high school students. It gives parents the most up-to-date information, knowledge and tools to empower them to talk honestly and openly with their children about the dangers of drugs.

"The more researchers examine the risks of teen substance abuse, the more it becomes clear that parents have an enormously powerful influence on their kids," noted Ms. Katz. "That's why it is so important to be able to communicate our drug and alcohol prevention message to as many parents in our community as possible."

Since launching the program in 2008, the Courage to Speak Foundation has trained 53 facilitators to offer the course to parents in Fairfield County and surrounding communities. Course topics include how to reduce the risk of drug and alcohol abuse; warning signs of drug and alcohol abuse; addiction and its consequences; abuse and misuse of over-the-counter and prescription medication; teen party culture; communication and listening strategies; strategies for helping your child handle stress; warning signs; the power of denial; and what to do and where to turn if abuse is suspected.

The Spanish version of *Courage to Speak - Courageous Parenting 101*TM will be launched in Norwalk in Fall 2010.
